	ACCOMMODATION
Housing	UCR does not have student residences for exchange students. However, students can look for housing by their own means, or through websites that will be sent to them by email, prior to the expected date of arrival, for them to rent the place of their choice.
	FINANCIAL INFORMATION
Tuition and Fees	Students from a university that has a specific student mobility agreement with the University of Costa Rica do not have to pay for tuition fees. However, there is a mandatory fee of approximately USD\$30 per semester. International students from universities that do not have an exchange agreement with the UCR must pay approximately USD\$1,100 per semester, depending on the exchange rate.
Financial Aid	UCR does not offer financial aid to visiting students.
INFORMATION AB	OUT THE COSTA RICAN ENTRY VISA AND THE PROCESS TO OBTAIN THE SPECIAL STUDENT CATEGORY
Entry Visa and Special Student Category Application.	Costa Rican Dirección General de Migración y Extranjería (General Directorate of Migration and Foreigners Office), divides the countries into 4 groups (see the following link): First Group of Countries: Nationals of countries from this group do not need to apply for the Special Student Category as long as their academic activities do not exceed 180 days. If students wish to study in Costa Rica for two academic cycles, they must apply for the Special Student Category and request a provisional student visa in the Costa Rican Consulate of their origin or residence country. Note: If exchange students enter the country without a provisional student visa, they must pay to the Government of Costa Rica USD\$200 penalty (it is an admissibility fee). If exchange students enter with the provisional student visa, which they must apply for at the Costa Rica Consulate in their country of origin or residence, they should not make this payment. Second, Third and Fourth Group of Countries: Nationals of countries from these groups of countries, must apply for the Special Student Category. In the case of students who must carry out immigration procedures, they will receive instructions and support from our Office.
	INSURANCE
Medical Insurance	Students must have an international insurance that covers their own needs, and that includes at least: hospitalization, pandemics such as COVID-19, considering the guidelines of the Costa Rican Ministry of Health, as well as surgery, dental emergencies, medical expenses, and repatriation of remains. This insurance must have coverage during the entire stay in Costa Rica. Students can get basic medical assistance at the UCR Health Office.
Vaccines	Students who come from South America must verify what the local vaccination requirements are (for example, yellow fever vaccine) for their departure and entry to Costa Rica.
